3. The appointment and services will be governed under-Residency of Govt. of India, Ministry of health and Family welfare and amendment thereafter/relaxation as detailed in eligibility criteria and in accordance of Office Order No. 86/DHA/2024 dated 27.06.2024.
4. Candidates appearing for the interview should bring Bank Draft/ Pay order of Rs. 1000/- (one thousand only) for Unreserved, EWS and OBC category, Rs. 500/- (five hundred only) for reserved category (SC, ST) in favour of "COMMISSIONER, MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF DELHI", payable at Delhi. No TA/DA will be paid for appearing in the interview. Persons with Disability are exempted from fee. "Fee submitted for the interview will be non-refundable".
5. Eligibility Criteria and recruitment process as in annexure A.
6. The qualification and experience will be counted up to the date of interview.
7. The candidate who is in service will have to bring 'No Objection Certificate' from his/her Head of Institution/employer at the time of interview otherwise he/she will not be allowed to appear for interview.
8. Those seeking benefits of reservation for SC/ST/OBC should submit caste certificate in his/her name issued by the competent authority (In case of OBC the valid certificate should be issued from competent authority of Govt. of India). All prospective candidates are advised to check their eligibility regarding admissibility of benefit of reservation accordingly.
9. Candidates of EWS category should submit the EWS certificate before the interview as mentioned in (Annexure B).
10. The doctors at any time found guilty of any gross misconduct or negligence of his/her duties shall be terminated without any notice or payment in lieu of notice period.
11. 04% of seats out of the sanctioned posts in the eligible specialties will be reserved for Persons with Disability. Reservation of Persons with Disability will be as per the Government rules.
12. A total of 1 post each will be reserved for Person with Disabilities (PWD) candidate with One Arm affected (OA) / One Leg affected (OL) in Non-surgical branch from amongst these advertised posts depending upon suitability and availability of candidates who apply. Persons with Disability are encouraged to apply.
13. In case of SC/ ST/OBC/EWS certificate reveals that claim belonging these categories

is false /fake the services will terminated without assigning any further reason or without prejudice. Further action may be taken under Indian penal code (IPC) for production fake and false certificate.

14. The candidates must bring Aadhaar Card at the time of interview.
15. **The candidate must have valid Registration with Delhi Medical Council / Delhi Dental Council at the time of interview.**
16. No TA/DA will be paid for appearing for interview.
17. No private practice whatsoever will be allowed during residency.
18. The doctors at any time found guilty of any gross misconduct or negligence of his/her duties shall be terminated without any notice or payment in lieu of notice period.
19. Other service conditions will be applicable as per service conditions prescribed from time to time by Government of India.
20. Inter hospital/inter institutional transfer shall not be permitted.



Educational Qualification	a) MBBS/BDS Degree from MCI/NMC Recognized University/Institution. b) PG degree/DNB/Diploma/MDS (for Dental) in concerned specialty from a recognized University/Institute registered with DMC/DDC/NMC/DCI. c) If adequate candidates as per (b) above are not available in particular Specialty, then candidates with MBBS Degree and having at least 02 years' experience in a Govt. recognized 100 bedded (minimum) hospital/Institution, out of which one year should be in concerned specialty, can be considered.
Duration of residency	For PG/ Diploma candidates, the engagement will be for a period of one year initially, extendable by one year at a time up to total of three years. For non PG candidate the engagement will be for six months initially followed by extension of six months each time. Extension is subject to satisfactory work & conduct report.
Tenure	a) Total tenure of Senior Residency will not normally exceed three years including the period served in other Govt. Hospitals. b) In case enough candidates are not available as per (a) above, then the candidates who have completed 3 years of senior residency but are willing to serve as Senior Residents will be allowed to appear in the interview. A separate list of such candidates will be prepared and this list will be considered after list of fresh candidate as per (a) above is exhausted. However total tenure of Senior Residency will not exceed five years including the period served in other Govt. Hospitals. (It is clarified that aforesaid provision (b) made in relaxation of the provisions of the Residency Scheme are only enabling provisions. In the first place the recruitments have to be made strictly as per the Residency Scheme as circulated by the Ministry of Health & Family welfare: vide GOI OM No.11014/3/91-ME (P) dated 05-6-1992.).
